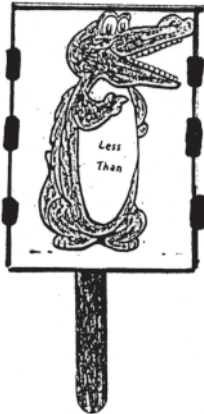


Song = Number Eating Alligator
CD = Math, Math, Math
Prop = Greater Than Less Than Alligator

(Remember, the alligator's mouth always eats the biggest number! This will result in the correct greater than, less than sign.)

Directions for the Alligator:

1. Cut along the broken line.
2. Fold along the dotted line.
3. Tape a large tongue depressor inside the folded area. Allow 1/2 of the stick to remain outside for a handle.
4. Staple along both sides.

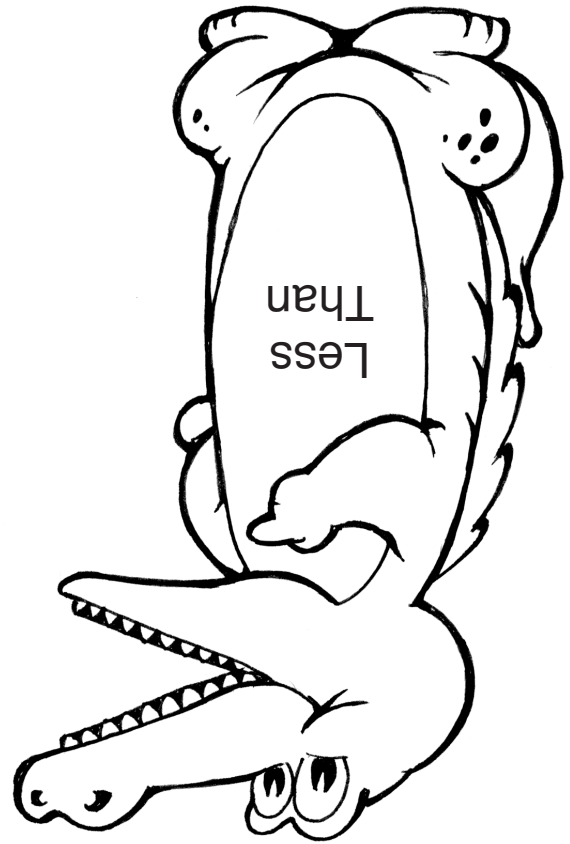


Students Can Use the Alligator to:

1. Sing along with the song and chomp with the alligator.
2. Compare two numbers written on white boards. Students simply lay the alligator on the board with the mouth "chomping" the largest number.
3. Compare two numbers written on the board by holding up their alligator toward the correct response. A "1,2,3, show me" response will give you an instant assessment.

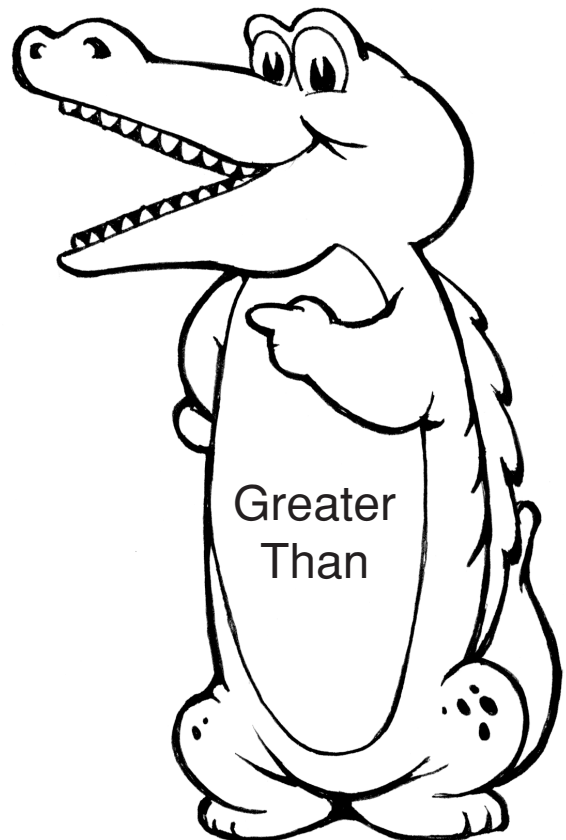
Greater Than, Less Than Chant:

Number Eating Alligator

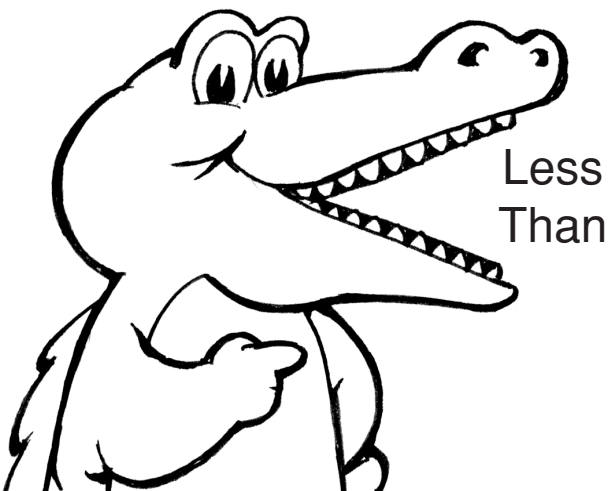
There once was a number eating alligator.

When two numbers came around.

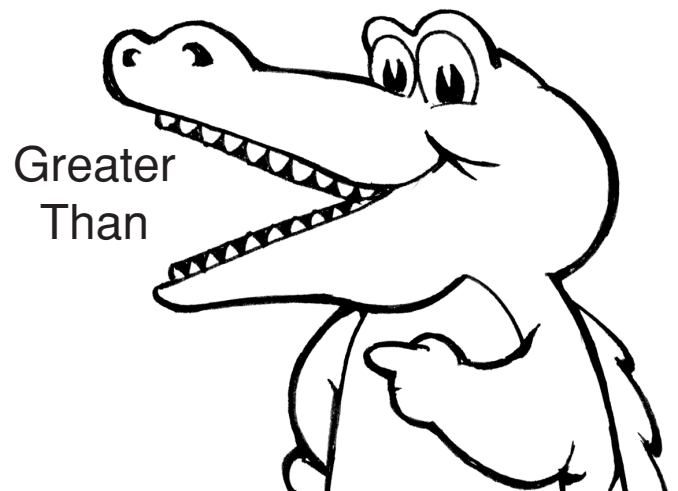
He'd compare the two
